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### **Use of ODL in Nauru:**

- ODL from Nauru's perspective is mainly catered for the unemployed, disadvantaged youth, youth in need of life skills and/or basic skills in particular TVET areas.
- COL materials have been used for the basic skills projects carried out in Nauru, in particular, the Basic Concrete and Literacy Training.

### **Top Priorities:**

- Developing the general population to be constructive and productive in their communities:
  - a) Drop-out youth and the general population to be skilled in basic skills of their choice.
  - b) Financially disadvantaged youth and the general financially disadvantaged population to be equipped with skills of their choice.
  - c) Youth with disabilities and the general disabled population to be equipped with basic skills of their choice or recommended skill by concerned officials.
  - d) Youth and the general population with learning problems to be equipped with basic skills of their choice (or recommended skills for a particular learning problem).
- To offer the general populace the choice of being trained for entrepreneurship skills.

### **How COL Can Further Support the National Agenda of Nauru:**

- By training specialised trainers for individuals with learning problems (disabled individuals, disadvantaged individuals, etc.)
- Resourcing funds for trainers.
- Resourcing funds for training resources and materials.
