Gender and Development Trends in Grenada

Health

Maternal mortality in Grenada has decreased steadily from 41 deaths per 100,000 in 1990, to 27 deaths per 100,000 in 2015 (WHO, 2015).

As of 2014, the Grenada Planned Parenthood Association had offices in two of the country's six parishes. At the time, there were no national awareness programme regarding family planning (Ministry of Social Development and Housing, 2014). 40 percent of young women in Grenada give birth before the age of 20 (UNFPA, 2014).

Education

More boys than girls are out of primary school in Grenada; a 2014 report by the Education Policy Data Centre indicated that 4% of boys of primary school age are out of school compared to 1% of girls of the same age (p.1).

Economy

Enterprise Surveys conducted by the Caribbean Development Bank (2013) revealed that the average small business employed nine full-time staff and two part-time workers. The disaggregation of employment and ownership by gender was fairly even: women were involved to some extent in the ownership of 56% of small firms, while 44% of permanent full-time workers were female (Caribbean Development Bank, 2013:10).

Governance

According to the Inter-Parliamentary Union, Grenada ranks thirty-fourth in the world, in terms of female representation in government. There are 5 women represented from a total of 15 lower house seats, marking a 33.3% representation (Inter-Parliamentary Union, 2017).

Human Rights

There are high rates of domestic violence and abuse, against both women and men in Grenada. In 2015, there were 696 reported cases of domestic abuse (479 females and 217 males), compared with 257 cases (184 females and 73 males) in 2014 (U.S. Department of State, 2016). Many women noted that they feared retribution, stigma, or further violence, and most were economically dependent on the perpetrators; for these reasons, domestic violence remains underreported (U.S. Department of State, 2016).

Grenada SDG Progress Profile

- Grenada was not included in the 2016 SDG Index and Dashboards due to insufficient data. According to a 2016 report (Bertelsmann Stiftung, 2016), the data from Grenada was missing 48% of the values needed to be ranked, and therefore was not included in any indicator data (Annex 2:39).
